





## **DONATIONS AND GIFT AID – GRESLEY CARRIAGES**

**Please note.** This form is only for donations for the 'Teak Train' Gresley carriages owned by the SVR Rolling Stock Trust Co Ltd (*Registered Charity 1092723*). Donations will be applied to current projects to meet ongoing expenditure unless you indicate that you wish to make a dedicated donation for a specific part in one of our project carriages (see separate leaflets).

NB. The Trust reserves the right to transfer any oversubscribed donations to an alternative 'Teak Train' project.

The SVR Rolling Stock Trust Co Ltd is a registered charity for the restoration and preservation of rolling stock for operation on the Severn Valley Railway. Among the historic carriages now owned by the Trust are five of the SVR's popular LNER varnished teak carriages. Restoring these carriages is a costly and never-ending task – and not funded by your fares! You can help in this by your donations to the Trust's projects, by sponsoring individual parts, by regular donations or by a general donation.

The Trust Company now owns the following Gresley carriages, each requiring finance for improvements:

No 7960 Kitchen Composite (Fitting-out completion)

No 52255 Tourist Third Open (See separate project leaflet)

<u>PAYROLL GIVING</u>: This is another way to help the work of the Trust. This scheme allows UK income tax payers to give regularly via any employer who runs the scheme. - 2. Remember to notify us if you no longer pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax equal to that being reclaimed by the Trust Company. Please also notify the Trust Company if you change your name or address whilst the declaration is in force. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Trust.
- 3. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
