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70759 IS A-CHANGING ~ A SIGNIFICANT STEP FORWARD!

The transformation of BG(P) 70759 into a Brake Third (BTK) has begun. At the Bridgnorth end, which will become the passenger accommodation, the first section of widened corridor side framework has been constructed over twelve weeks. This 9' length, between the guard's door and the nearest passenger door, was fitted in place on 13th and 14th March. The framework is made entirely of recycled timber from 70442, 70759 and Birmingham University.

The aim is to make and fit the remaining two corridor side framework sections before the end of 2012. The five sections needed on the compartment side should follow in 2013.

The pictures show the new framing along with, for comparison, the side of our Brake Composite 24068, which illustrates how the passenger section of the body is wider than the parcels/brake area. This is a characteristic feature of Gresley vehicles. Easily missed – but have a look next time you are on the SVR. The width of 70759, as a pigeon/brake, followed the narrower dimension over its full length. (Pictures 1 and 2 by Mike Cranmore; that of 24068 by Richard Hill)







Meanwhile at the 'Stourport end', which will remain in its original "Pigeon Van" form, great strides are being made to clean, de-bug, repair and recycle enough of the original planking to clad the interior. About half the planks have been completed and fitted with enough for a third section. The fourth and final section includes the space in front of the guard's compartment, for which we *may* need to buy some new planking.

New toughened glass has recently been bought for the toplights that will be retained at the Stourport van end, and a start made on fitting. The team has also commenced cleaning down and inspecting the exterior doors. Three doors have been dealt with so far, and some repairs will be necessary before these can be hung on the carriage.

Finally, the teak panels have arrived in the UK and will soon be coming to Bewdley accompanied by a large bill. Many panels are still available for sponsorship. Details may be found by clicking the link –
